NEWPORT BOROUGH COUNCIL MID-MONTH MEETING July 16, 2024

President Greg Shope called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the following Borough Council Members present: Christian Fickes, Penny Frownfelter, Barbara Leach, Mary Bucher, Tami Halstead, and Billie Dudley

President Shope asked Cl'm Fickes to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Shope announced that the meeting was being recorded.

APPROVAL OF JULY'S BILLS TO DATE: Treasurer Damiano

Gibson-Thomas Engineering Co., Inc. payment was split between 4 checks due to various grants:

- 4. General Fund Engineering

MOTION: Cl'm Dudley moved, seconded by Cl'm Frownfelter to pay the July bills presented for payment. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE No. 385 Amending Ordinance Chapter 215 Streets and Sidewalks: adding Sidewalk Cafés and Street Events: Council Discussion

- 1. Section 215-20: Permit year begins in January. Possible to prorate fees if initial permit began during the year. Fees have yet to be determined by council.
- 2. Section 215-20: Operation hours; Should be eliminated.
- 3. Section 215-22: Fee schedule: Will be passed by Resolution.
- 4. (2) Separate Permits: Street Event Permit and Alcohol Permit.
- 5. Provide physical permits for locality.
- 6. Intent of adding Sidewalk Cafés: To be pertinent for all businesses requesting to extend their business into the outdoor space of the sidewalk adjacent to their building.
- 7. Indemnification for Newport Borough
- 8. Purpose of Ordinance: 1. Revenue 2. Uniformity
- 9. Limited to Downtown District: already established
- 10. As per Cl'm Halstead: Cl'm Fickes formulated the ordinance, had it reviewed by an attorney and the borough solicitor, and then had Ordinance Committee tweak the ordinance content.
- 11. Street Events section would allow alcohol, thus legalizing those vendors that are within this category to participate in the Food Truck Festival.
- 12. Insurance coverage amounts of at least \$25,000/\$50,000: Both the independent attorney and the solicitor agreed on the wording of "at least" amount of insurance coverage. Requiring more might affect small businesses. The liability insurance of the nonprofit Host of the event is provided to the borough for insurance coverage.

MOTION: Cl'm Leach moved, seconded by Cl'm Dudley to tentatively approve Ordinance #385 Amending Ordinance #348 Chapter 215 Streets and Sidewalks: adding Sidewalk Café and Street Events with the following clerical changes:

Additions in **bold**: Deletions in *italics*.

- 1. §215-19 Definitions: PERMIT APPLICATION-establish a sidewalk café.
- 2. §215-20 Sidewalk Cafes: [Deletion of 2nd sentence in subsection a.] a. Sidewalk café is limited to table service only with at least two tables.
- 3. §215-20 Sidewalk Cafes: [Deletion of subsection c.] c. The maximum hours of operation shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. prevailing time.

MOTION: Cl'm Leach moved, seconded by Cl'm Dudley to tentatively approve Ordinance #386 Amending Ordinance #348 Chapter 72 Alcoholic Beverages with the following clerical changes: Additions in **bold**:

- 1. In the first paragraph, capitalization of "B": and the **B**orough Code,
- 2. In the second paragraph, all lower-case letters of the first "the": WHEREAS, the Borough
- 3. §72-2 Illegal to transport or possess open containers: First sentence, insert "an":consume in **an** open container...
